How to Store Projects + Materials

- Storage cubbies in the Making Center are available to any TNS student on a weekly basis
- Storing and labelling your projects and materials correctly is your responsibility
- Out-of-date or unlabelled materials WILL BE DISCARDED weekly without prior warning

Black Cubby Storage	For storing materials and works-in-progress only Finished work should be taken home Materials must fit entirely inside shelf Must be renewed weekly or will be discarded
Large Project Storage	Limited availability near the entrance to the N2 shop. These cubbies are for oversized material only Must be renewed weekly or will be discarded
Projects Left Out (not in a cubby)	Will be discarded after 24 hours If you need additional time to figure out transport, you must communicate directly with shop techs.
Flammable Materials	Oils, stains, spray paint, and other flammable materials cannot be stored in the Making Center Cubbies. Improperly stored flammables will be moved to the L3 spray booth flammables cabinet. The flammables cabinet is emptied at the end of each semester.

Banned Materials + Processes

Allowed	Not Allowed
Carving, cutting, or assembling wood using hand tools	Power sanding without proper ventilation
Cutting and bending metal using hand tools or metal shear/roller	Mold-making/casting with plaster, resin, concrete, fiberglass, alginate, or wax*
Ceramic hand building on ware boards	Spray paint/Airbrush* Use of flammable oils, stains, adhesives, or
Painting and drawing using non-toxic dry or wet mediums	otherwise toxic materials
Wood finishing with water-based treatments	Heat guns or any application of heat to plastics, acrylic, or plexiglass

*Spray booth and casting room are located on L3

*Plaster/cement allowed in Wet Shop
